

2016 MASST INCOME ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

To be eligible for the MASST program participants must be at least age 55 and older, unemployed, and low-income individuals.

Persons in family poverty guideline

1	\$18,550
2	\$25,025
3	\$31,500
4	\$37,975
5	\$44,450
6	\$50,925
7	\$57,400
8	\$63,900

For each additional person, add: \$6,500

Note: The State of Alaska and its subrecipients should make particular effort to serve those with “greatest economic needs,” meaning those who are at or below the 100 percent level. The poverty guidelines issued here are a simplified version of the poverty thresholds that the Census Bureau uses to prepare its estimates of the number of individuals and families in poverty accomplished by increasing the latest published Census Bureau poverty thresholds by the relevant percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U).
